## ENABLING CONDITIONS

- Supportive policies (land tenure, human rights, etc.)
- Social science research + capacity

## OUTPUTS

- Percent of women/indigenous people/ youth participating/with leadership roles
- Percent of women/indigenous people/ youth accessing inputs
- Percent of women/indigenous people/ youth accessing services
- Percent women/indigenous people/youth

## INVESTMENTS

- \$ invested in gender programs
- \$ invested in indigenous people programs
- \$ invested in youth engagement programs

## ACTIONS

- Identify marginalized populations + engage
- Identify barriers + needs
- Training (leadership, management, skills, GAP, etc.)
- PO governance + membership requirements
- Business development + organization strengthening
- Develop credit + savings programs
- Develop policy + legal support
- Monitoring + adapting

## OUTCOMES

- Increased representation of women, youth + minorities in decision making + planning within value chains
- Increased representation of women, youth + minorities in decision making + planning within communities
- Increased adoption of good agricultural practices
- Professionalism among farmers + cooperatives (farmer organization)
